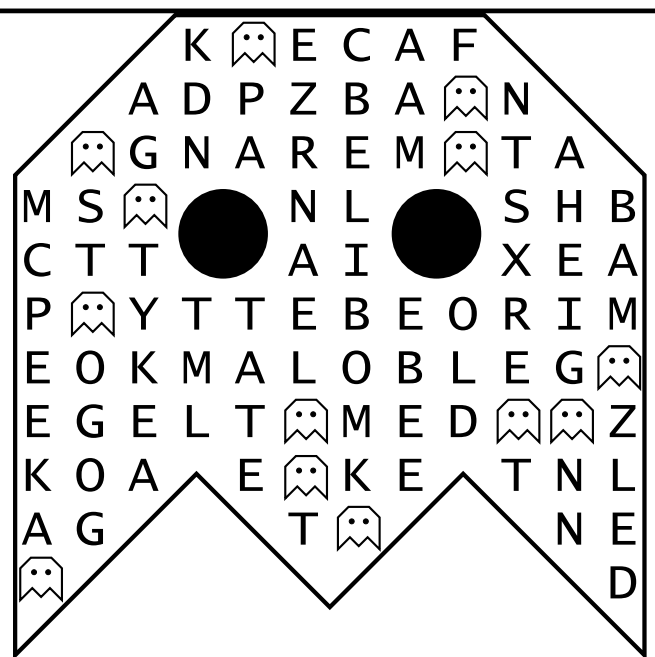

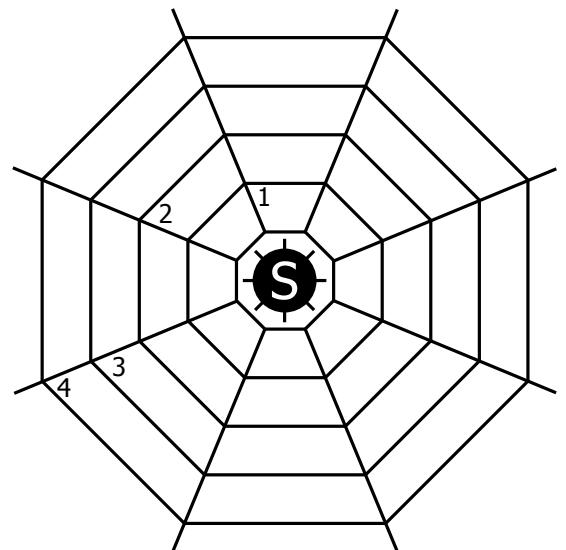

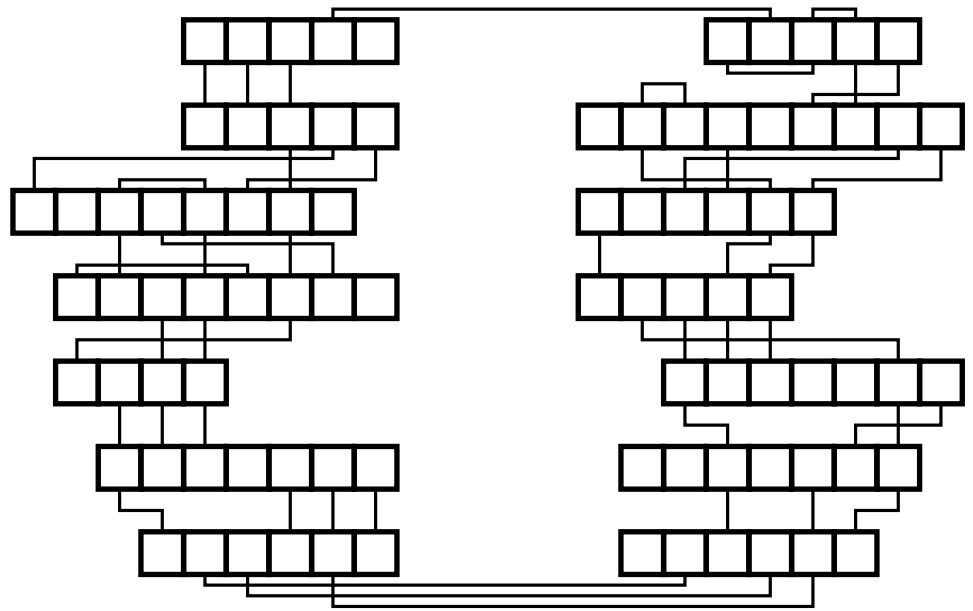

Each rectangle is filled with the name of a scary creature you might see on Halloween, one letter per box. Boxes that are connected by a line hold the same letter.



Trick or Treat

The answer to each pair of clues is two words that make a phrase "___ or ___." However, before I wrote the clues, I gave one word a "trick," where I changed a letter, and I gave the other a "treat," where I added a letter. The clues are for the new words, which may be in either trick/treat or treat/trick order. For example, "Trick or treat" might be clued as "Vehicle / Menace" (Truck or Threat) or as "Difficult / Awesome" (Tricky or Great).
