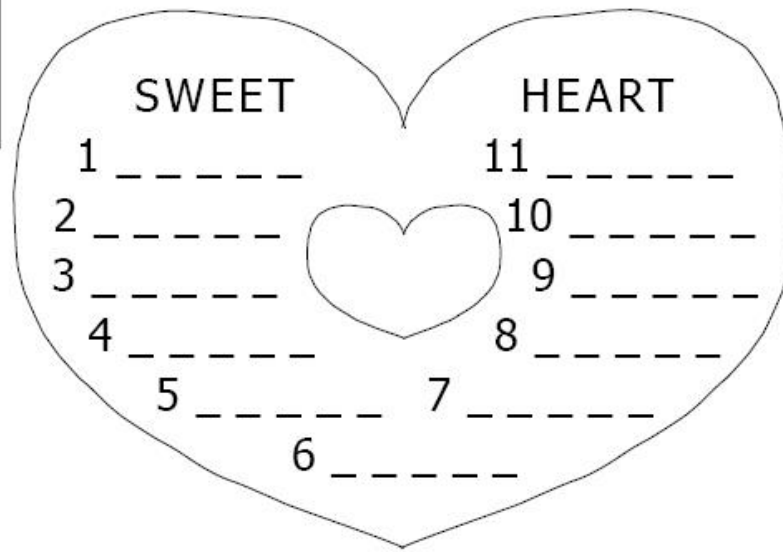


It's a week of Valentine's - themed puzzles!

### Heart to Heart

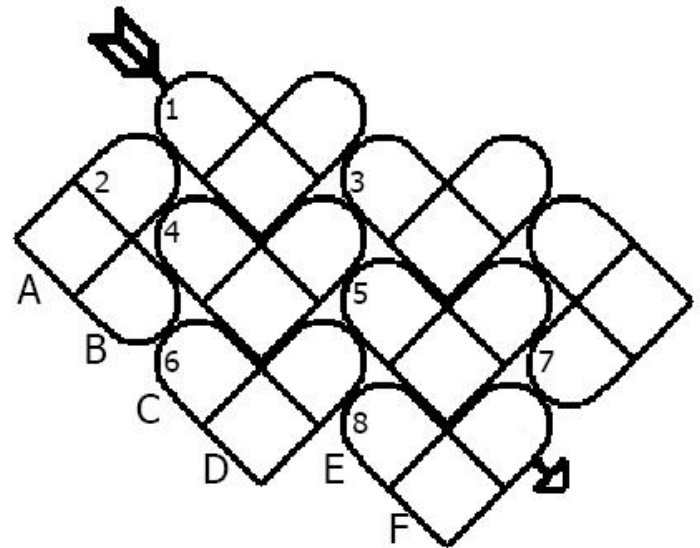

8. Word after ask or go

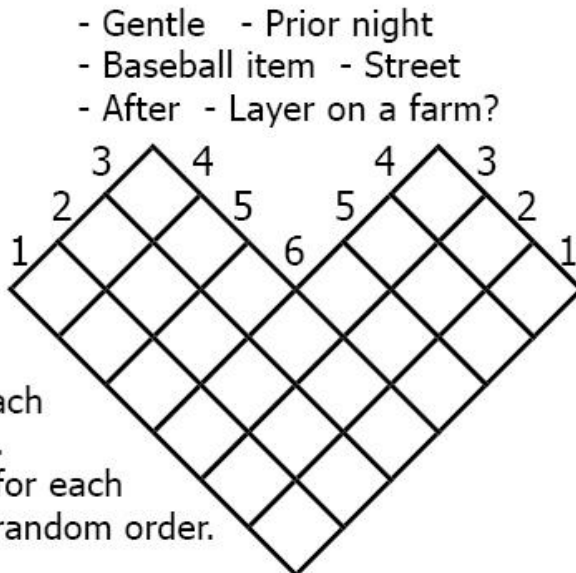

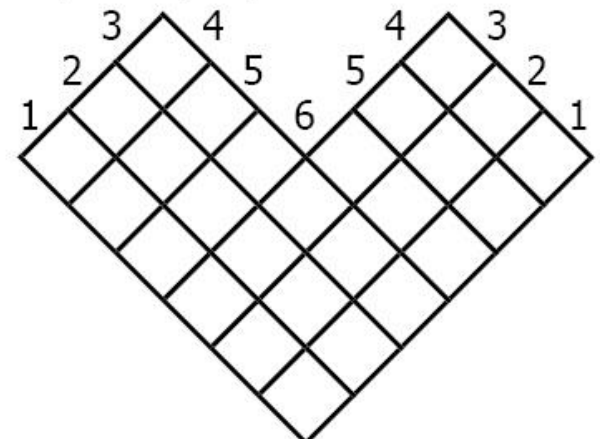


### Autocrossword

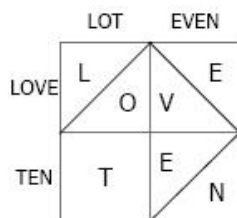

### Plot Lines

Squares contain either one or two letters. If a square contains two, you must separate the letters with a diagonal line, which might go in either direction, as in the example. Note how the first box reads "LO" both ways, while the second box reads "VE" across, but "EV" down.
