

Re-Cycled Words by Dustin Foley

Inspired by Eric Berlin's "Circular Reasoning"

Each cycle needs a missing letter to spell a word with all its letters. But each cycle has 2 answers! One answer is clockwise and matches the first clue, and the other is counter-clockwise and matches the second clue. The starting position could be anywhere, and might be different for the 2 answers. When you match the solution pairs at the bottom, you'll get a well-known set of circles.
