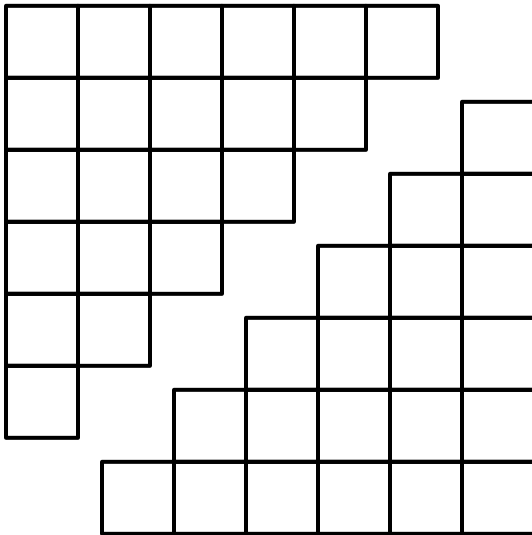


Shapeshifters

If you move the two shapes together horizontally, you'll form 7 rows of 6-letter answers. If you instead move them together vertically, you'll form 6 rows of 7-letter answers. When you complete both puzzles, you might discover something going downhill fast.
